2007-08 GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL RELEASE FOUR GSC MEN'S BASKETBALL HEADED TO NCAA TOURNAMENT CBU, HU, UNA AND OBU EARN BIDS

Birmingham, AL—For the second time in three seasons, the Gulf South Conference placed at least four teams in the NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Tournament.

The selections also marked the seventh straight year that the league has sent at least three teams to the post-season

The eight-team NCAA South Regional will be hosted by Sunshine State Conference Champion Florida Southern in Lakeland, FL.

The Conference accounted for the fourth through sixth seeds. **GSC East Division Champion North Alabama** garnered the No. 4 seed, while **GSC Tri-West Division Champions** and **GSC Tournament Champion Christian Brothers** earned the No. 5 spot. The two remaining West Division Tri-Champions rounded out the field with **Harding** claiming the No. 6 spot and **Ouachita Baptist** notching No. 8

The Tournament tips off on Saturday, March 15 at 12:00 pm (Eastern), followed by the Semi-Finals on Sunday, and the Championship Game on Tuesday, March 18 at 7 pm.

The GSC first takes the court in Game Two when Harding (18-12) meets No. 3 seed Tampa (20-8) at 2:30 pm. HU appears in second all-time NCAA post-season after claiming its lone spot in 2003. The Bisons seek their first-ever victory after falling in the 2003 Quarter-Finals to league rival Henderson State. The GSC is 5-3 versus Tampa in the NCAA Tournament, taking the first four meetings before following with three straight losses and a victory in 2002. The matchup is HU's first versus a SSC team this year.

Game Three features Ouachita Baptist versus top-seeded Florida Southern at 5:00 pm. OBU makes it's first-ever appearance in the NCAA Tournament, following it's first-ever share of the GSC West Division crown earlier this season. The Tigers and FSC meet for the first time ever. OBU is 1-2 versus the rest of the Regional field.

North Alabama and Christian Brothers face off for the second time in two weeks after CBU downed UNA in the Semi-Finals of the GSC Tournament, 80-69. CBU is 14-6 all-time versus UNA with the squads splitting the last four meetings. North Alabama makes its 12th appearance in the post-season, building a 27-10 record and claiming the 1979 and 1991 National Championships. The Lions have advanced to six Elite Eight's and are 17-4 in NCAA Regional action. UNA is 1-2 versus the Regional field this season. On the other hand, Christian Brothers is a newcomer to the NCAA Tournament since moving up from the NAIA ranks in 1996-97. The Bucs are 4-2 versus the Regional field the season.

The winner of the South Region advances to the NCAA Division II Elite Eight, scheduled for March 26-27, 29 at the MassMutual Center in Springfield, Mass.

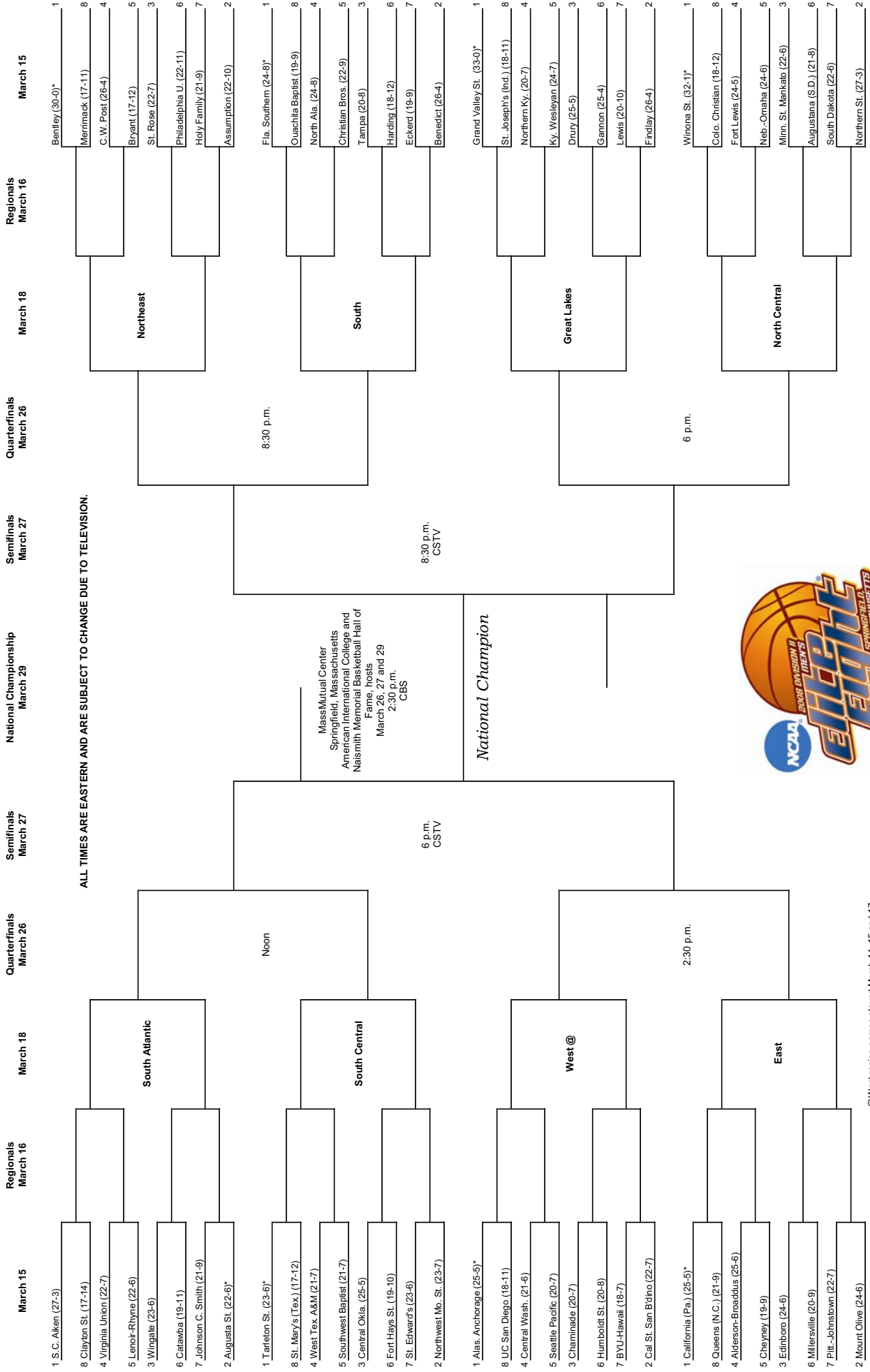

2008 GSC MEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT RECAP

OPENING ROUND--WEDNESDAY, MARCH 5

The West Division teams made their presence felt in the in the Opening Round of the 2008 GSC Men's Basketball Tournament at the DeSoto Civic Center in Southaven, Miss., taking both Opening Round matchups versus the East.

No. 5 West seed Arkansas Tech tipped off the Tournament, upsetting No. 4 East seed Alabama-Huntsville, 65-49. Arkansas Tech's defense showed up early, limiting UAH to only 20 percent shooting in the first half. ATU held a 31-16 advantage going into the locker room, but the Chargers came out of the halftime firing, equaling their field goals from the first half in the first three minutes.

UAH hit four of its first seven shots and got within double-digits at 33-24. However, the surge lost steam and ATU regained control of the game rebuilding a 16-point 42-26 lead. ATU answered with a 6-1 run to push their lead back to 55-42. The Chargers got within 10 one more time, but never got closer than nine the rest of the way.

Cody Jones led the Chargers with 12 points and five rebounds. Flowers scored a season-high 22 points and grabbed 11 rebounds to lead ATU. Brandon Friedel and Chad Henderson added 10 apiece. Arkansas Tech posted its first post-season victory since 1996 and first as a Division II member.

No. 4 West seed Arkansas-Monticello squeaked past No. 5 East seed Montevallo, 63-61, in the final game of the night. UAM got out of the blocks early, going on a strong run to take the lead at half. The Boll Weevil's defense clamped down on the Falcons, limiting Montevallo to 34 percent shooting in the first half.

Arkansas-Monticello stretched out their advantage, but failed to close the door as the Falcons continued to chip away at the lead. UAM held a margin as high as 13 at one point, only to see Montevallo climb within one with a minute remaining. UM actually took the lead with under a minute left, with Humphrey's free throws making it 61-60 Montevallo. UAM quickly answered, as March Baham made a layup to reclaim the advantage. Montevallo had a chance to win in the final shot, but a turnover gave Arkansas-Monticello at hard fought victory.

The men retake the court with Quarter-Final action on Friday, March 7th beginning with No. 1 West seed Harding versus Arkansas Tech at 12:30 pm. No. 2 East seed Valdosta State takes on No. 3 West seed Ouachita Baptist at 2:45 pm. No. 1 East seed North Alabama locks horns with Arkansas-Monticello at 5:30 pm, followed by No. 2 West seed Christian Brothers and No. 3 East seed West Georgia.

QUARTER-FINALS--FRIDAY, MARCH 7

The upset bug did not bite in the Semi-Finals of the 2008 GSC Men's Basketball Tournament at the DeSoto Civic Center in Southaven, Miss., as all higher seeded teams notched victories.

No. 1 West seed Harding opened the day, breezing past No. 5 West seed Arkansas Tech, 73-51. HU's victory was its first over ATU after dropping both regular season matchups. The game was tied 24-24 before the Bisons put together an 8-0 run enroute to a 32-24 halftime edge. Harding picked up where it left off in the second half, going on a 9-1 run and never trailing the rest of the way. GSC West Player of the Year Matt Hall poured in a game-high 22 points, while Kevin Brown added 17 points coming off the bench.

No. 2 East seed Valdosta State and No. 3 West seed Ouachita Baptist provided plenty of drama in the second game of the day with VSU earning an 81-79 overtime triumph. The game marked the first overtime GSC Tournament contest since 2006 (West Georgia vs. Henderson State). VSU led the majority of the first half, before the Tigers grabbed their first lead at the seven-minute mark.

Ouachita Baptist held the lead into the locker room, 39-34, and extended the edge to as much as eight in the second frame. The Blazers did not give up, taking its first lead of the half on Ricky Coleman's three-pointer at 5:11. OBU forced overtime when Jaranimo Marks nailed a three-pointer of his own with 20 ticks on the clock.

The game continued to be close in overtime with OBU taking a one-point lead with 50 seconds remaining, but VSU battled for a two-point lead with 12 seconds left. The Tigers had a chance to force a second overtime, but Daniel Maddox's runner at the buzzer bounced off the rim. Two VSU players posted double-doubles: Devario Hudson (19 points, 14 rebounds) and Tristan Crawford (10 points and 10 rebounds). Stephan Walton added a game-high 21 points.

No. 1 East seed North Alabama had not played a game in 10 days, but the rust did not show as the Lions eased past No. 4 West seed Arkansas-Monticello, 87-69. The game was a rollercoaster ride in the first half. UAM pulled within six points at 13:03 only to see UNA stretch the lead to 17 at 8:16. The Boll Weevils did not give up, cutting deficit to nine points at the break, 55-46. North Alabama held firm in the second half, leading by as much as 22 points. UNA had six players score in double-digits, led by Quinn Beckwith's 18 points. Forward Casey Holt added a double-double with 11 points and 15 rebounds.

No. 2 West seed Christian Brothers completed the higher-seed sweep, topping No. 3 East seed West Georgia, 76-68. CBU was red hot from the field in the first half, shooting 70.0 percent while UWG shot just 28.6 percent en route to a 36-21 halftime lead. The Bucs seemed to have the game in hand in the second half, leading by as much as 21 points until UWG single-digits down the stretch. CBU iced the contest when Reggie Peyton nailed a pair of free throws with 12 second left. Bucs' center Nick Kohs posted a game-high 23 points and 14 rebounds, while Kevin Weybright added 23 points.

The men take the court again tomorrow with Semi-Final action which starts with Harding versus Arkansas-Monticello at 5:30 pm. North Alabama and Christian follow, tipping off at 7:30 pm.

SEMIFINALS--SATURDAY, MARCH 8

One thing is for sure when Harding battles Christian Brothers in tomorrow's 2008 GSC Men's Basketball Tournament at the DeSoto Civic Center in Southaven, Miss—There will be a first-ever GSC Champion!

No. 1 West seed Harding advanced to its first-ever Championship Game, topping No. 2 seed Valdosta State, 89-84. The teams combined for 96 points in the first half with VSU owning a 49-47 lead at the break. HU led 83-82 with just 58 seconds left in the game, but the Bisons closed the game by outscoring the Blazers 6-2. Harding's Matt Hall racked up a game-best 35 points on 11-of-20 shooting, while Steven Barnett added 15 points and six rebounds.

No. 2 West seed Christian Brothers completed the night, advancing to its first-ever Final by shocking No. 1 East seed North Alabama, 80-69. CBU was red hot from the field in the first half, jumping out to a 13 point lead twice in the first half while shooting 53.6 percent from the field. UNA found its footing late in the second half, pulling within two points at 3:18, but the Bucs pulled away by hitting eight straight free throws down the stretch. CBU's Kevin Weybright netted a game-high 23 points, while Nick Kohs notched a double-double (17 points, 14 rebounds).

Harding and Christian Brothers lock horns for the third time this season, with each squad earning a victory including CBU's home triumph a week ago. The game will tip off at 2:45 pm and will be broadcast live on CSS and tape delayed at 7:00 pm on CoxSports.

CHAMPIONSHIP--SUNDAY, MARCH 9

Christian Brothers University captured its first-ever GSC Men's Basketball Championship Title, defeating West Division rival Harding, 93-89, at the DeSoto Civic Center in Southaven, Miss. on Sunday.

CBU center Nick Kohs, the tournament's Most Outstanding Player, led the way with 28 points and a game-high 16 rebounds. The Bucs led by as many as 16 points in the first half, thanks to a 19-6 run. Christian Brothers pushed its 43-29 halftime lead to as many as 23 points in the second frame and the No. 2 West seed seemed on cruise control until the Bisons began their charge.

HU cut the deficit to nine with 6:25 left in the contest, before the lead ballooned back to 14. Harding did not give up closing the gap to nine with 44 seconds left and putting a scare in to the Buccaneers, pulling with four with 17 ticks on the clock. Justin Ray sealed the victory, nailing a free throw one tick on the clock.

CBU forward Kevin Weybright added 23 points, while guard Reggie Peyton netted 17. Harding freshman guard Kevin Brown came off the bench to lead all players with 33 points in a losing effort.

The game was the highest score GSC Championship game ever, dating back to 1981. The Buccaneers locked up an automatic berth the NCAA Tournament, while Harding holds out hopes for an at-large bid.
