Six-time GSC Champions **West Florida** aims to build on league history in attempting to claim its fourth consecutive title. The Argos received four first-place votes and 24 points but will have to stave off **Christian Brothers** (two first-place votes, 20 points).

Harding and **Alabama-Huntsville** were chosen to join the Argos and Bucs in Pensacola, Fla. for the 2009 GSC Tournament with 17 and 15 points, respectively.

Delta State finished fifth with eight points while **Ouachita Baptist** completed the voting with six points.

2009 PRESEASON ALL-GSC TEAM

New names adorn the 2009 Preseason All-GSC Men's Soccer Team as just one player from last year's squad returns and six players from the 2008 All-GSC team earned honors.

Christian Brothers and **Harding** led all schools with three selections each. The Bucs are led by one of the two unanimous choices in senior **midfielder Gordon Blum** and 2008 First Team All-GSC honorees, **defender Robert Mingo** and **midfielder Clark Bradford**. Leading the way for the Bisons are 2008 First Team All-GSC and the reigning *Freshman of the Year* **Phillip McCormick**. The sophomore is joined by Second Team selection **Chad Marshall** and **midfielder Connor Galloway**.

Alabama-Huntsville followed CBU and HU with two choices, **goalkeeper Tyler Earley** and **forward Myles Harding**. **West Florida**, **Delta State** and **Ouachita Baptist** each placed one player on the team. Argo **midfielder Paul Willoughby** was the other unanimous selection following his Second Team nod in 2008. **Forward David Horstmann** represents the Statesmen while 2008 Second Team honoree **Alex Tonrey** of the Tigers round out the preseason All-GSC contingent.

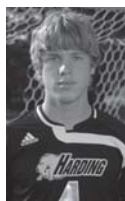
