

Phalaenopsis Orchid

Light: Indirect sunlight, taking care to avoid direct sunlight as leaves will burn easily.

Water: Water once a week, just often enough to keep continuous moisture below the surface of the medium but avoid overwatering. Phalaenopsis enjoy moist air, with a humidity level of 55-75%. Placing your plant over a tray or dish of moistened pebbles can increase moisture. Fertilize with a high-nitrogen fertilizer once a month at 1 teaspoon per gallon of water. When the last bloom drops, cut spike halfway down the stem, continue caring for plant and wait for possible re-bloom.
